Tucker's Tips

Protection from the Sun

It is important to protect your skin while enjoying the outdoors on a summer day. Below are some tips to help avoid the discomfort of a sunburn:

Do Not Burn

Sunburns significantly increase one's lifetime risk of developing skin cancer, especially for children.

Avoid Sun Tanning and Tanning Beds

UV Light from tanning beds and the sun cause skin cancer and wrinkling. Make sure to apply the proper amounts of sunscreen and stay protected at all times.

Generously Apply Sunscreen

Apply the sunscreen to cover all exposed skin 20 minutes before going outside. Sunscreen should have a Sun Protection Factor (SPF) of at least 15 and provide protection from both ultraviolet A (UVA) and ultraviolet B (UVB) rays. Reapply every two hours, even on cloudy days, and after swimming or eating.

Wear Protective Clothing

Wear protective clothing, such as a long-sleeved shirt, pants and wide-brimmed hat, and sunglasses, when possible.

Check the UV Index

The UV Index provides important information to help you plan your outdoor activities in ways that prevent sun overexposure. The UV Index forecast is issued daily by the National Weather Service and EPA.

Recent Verdicts & Settlements

Warner Law Offices Obtains Settlement For Client in Negligent Death Case

A settlement has been reached with one of the defendants in a lawsuit brought by Warner Law Offices on behalf of the Estate of a young man who was involuntarily admitted to an alcohol treatment facility and then passed away when he did not receive proper medical attention. The alcohol treatment facility has settled the Estate's claim for its policy limits, however, the lawsuit continues against other defendants allegedly responsible for the young man's death.

Young Victim of Abuse Will Receive Settlement Payments Throughout Her Adult Life

Through her biological father, Warner Law Offices filed suit on behalf of a little girl against child protective services for failing to remove her from an abusive home. The little girl's disclosure of abuse was investigated, a criminal complaint was filed and the perpetrator was arrested and jailed. Warner Law Offices obtained a settlement for the little girl, which has been placed in an interest bearing trust account which will make periodic lump sum payments to her throughout her adult life.
